DETAILED POSITION DESCRIPTIONS

In NFC, each position has its own uniqueness. They are designed to best fit a wide range of schedules so all staff members and professors on Moorpark College Campus have an opportunity to be apart of Nature's Finest Club. We hope you find a position that best suits you and your interests.

Club Advisor

As Club Advisor, you will be directly overseeing the club's activities. Club Advisors are in great communication with the president and elected officers. This person leads them on the right path and gives them the advice they need to succeed. Tasks the person in this position may encounter include: reading & approving documents, attending meetings/ events, and regularly communicating with club president and officers. The Club Advisor guides the students and does what one can to help the students achieve extracurricular excellence. This position is great for a staff member or professor who is eager to support a strong group of students and can dedicate about 4 hours each week to Nature's Finest Club related activities.

Faculty Advisor

As Faculty Advisor, you will be overseeing the Nature's Finest Student Internship Program. This is a program that Nature's Finest Club is proud to offer to the students of Moorpark College. The Faculty Advisor ensures the students enrolled in the internship are having a positive learning experience. This person is in direct communication with a selected group of interns which one will meet with at least 3 times over the course of the semester. This position is for staff members and professors who have an interest in the art of Husbandry and/or would love to help students engage and re-connect to the natural environment. Faculty Advisors also get a generous stipend.

Work Site Supervisor

As Work Site Supervisor, you will be overseeing the experience of the student interns at the work site. The Work Site Supervisor understands the learning objectives and is there to maintain a safe working environment for all interns. Tasks the person in this position may encounter include: regular site checks, communication with the Faculty Advisor, and approving internship paper-work. This position is great for the staff member or professor who can't dedicate lots of time, but still wants to be involved.

Committee Chairperson

As Committee Chairperson, you will be making decisions, creating goals, and monitoring all aspects of The Nature's Finest Student Organization. This committee is a collection of all advisors, supervisors, and employees who are affiliated with Nature's Finest. The Committee Chair will organize meetings, plan agendas, and lead discussions at Committee Meetings. This position requires a staff member who is dedicated to the preservation and progression of the Nature's Finest student mission and can dedicate about 2 hours each week to the organization.
